RE: Basketball Tickets/Advance Sales for the
Clovis vs Hobbs Boys Basketball Game

Tickets for the regular season Clovis vs Hobbs boy's basketball game on Friday, February 5th, will go on sale in the CHS athletic office on *Monday, February 1st at 7:30 am*. Tickets are \$5.00 for students (grades 1-12), \$5.00 for adults, and \$3.00 for senior citizens (62+).

Students and staff who have activity tickets and want to sit in the lower level **MUST** come by the Athletic Office to have their activity ticket punched to exchange for a lower level ticket. (Staff members with activity tickets will get two tickets) The number of lower level seats is very limited because half of that area is reserved. You must have the "special ticket" or a reserved seat ticket to sit in the lower level. After the lower level seats are sold out, upper level tickets will be issued for activity tickets. At the door, people with activity tickets will be able to get into the game (**if tickets have not sold out**) but will have to sit in the upper level. There will be a *limited number* of seats available for the lower and upper level. Tickets will be sold on a first-come-first-served basis.

Tickets sold at the door, if available, will be for the UPPER LEVEL ONLY. We also must make tickets available for the Hobbs fans, and our capacity is monitored by the Fire Marshall.
