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WILDCAT MARCHING BAND FINISHES 3rd AT "BANDS OF AMERICA" REGIONAL COMPETITION

The Wildcat Marching Band competed this past weekend in St. George, Utah. The band competed in the "Red Rocks Marching Festival" where they were awarded "Best Visual Performance" and placed 3rd overall.

Additionally, the Wildcat Marching Band competed in the "Bands of America" Regional Competition. Top marching bands from California, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, Texas, and Utah were represented. Twenty-six bands competed in the preliminary round and only the top ten moved to the finals. The Wildcat Marching Band made the finals where they finished 3rd.

This win marks the highest finish for Clovis at a "Bands of America" Regional contest and places the Wildcat Marching Band as one of the top bands in the West.

The Wildcat Marching Band is under the direction of Bill Allred and assisted by Brandon Boerio, Karl Powell, Travis Pruitt, Keith Sacane, Ty Frederick, and Teddy Guevara.
