CLOVIS MUNICIPAL SCHOOLS SELECTED AS A 'BEST COMMUNITY FOR MUSIC EDUCATION'

National Association of Music Merchants (NAMM) Foundation announced Clovis Municipal Schools was selected as a 2010 Best Communities for Music Education. And, Clovis Municipal Schools was the only school district in New Mexico to be selected for this designation.

The 2010 survey, which began January 17 and ended March 12, 2010, was available to all districts nationwide. Teachers and school district administrators, representing communities across the country, participated in the web-based survey. The districts were measured across curricular and programmatic criteria as well as public support of their music programs.

Each school receiving the "Best Communities" designation scored in the 80th percentile or higher in the survey's grading process. Participants in the survey answered detailed questions about funding, graduation requirements, music class participation, instruction time, facilities, support for the music program, and other relevant factors in their communities' music education programs.

Clovis Municipal Schools won this designation because of the example they set in providing quality school-based music education programs to young people in our community.

The NAMM Foundation is a nonprofit organization, founded in 2007, with the mission of advancing active participation in music making across the lifespan by supporting scientific research, philanthropic giving, and public service programs from the international music products industry.
