CLOVIS MUNICIPAL SCHOOLS ANNOUNCES NEW SUPERINTENDENT

Clovis Municipal Schools' Board of Education announced Wednesday evening that it has selected, Terry Myers, Superintendent of Schools in the Mount Pleasant Independent School District, Mount Pleasant, Texas, as the next Superintendent. Members of the Board selected Mr. Myers after interviewing three other candidates.

Myers, 54, has served as the Superintendent of Schools in Mount Pleasant for five years. Prior to his service in Mount Pleasant, he was Superintendent of Schools in the Cleveland Independent School District, Castleberry Independent School District, and Nueces Canyon Consolidated Independent School District. Myers has also served as a teacher, coach, and principal.

The Mount Pleasant Independent School District enrolls approximately 5,400 students and has been a "Recognized" school district in the State of Texas.

Mark Lansford, Board President, stated, "Terry Myers brings a proven track record of success to our school system. He has served effectively in four other superintendentcies and is highly regarded by Board and community members in the school systems he has served. Mr. Myers has successfully served all students and demonstrated effectiveness in working with minority and economically disadvantaged children."

Contract terms for Mr. Myers include a three-year contract with a base salary of \$151,000. Board President Lansford stated that Terry Myers has been offered a competitive contract commensurate with the duties and responsibilities as well as the expectations of this Board and community.

When contacted regarding the position, Myers stated, "It is a great honor to have been selected as Superintendent of Schools by the Clovis Municipal Schools' Board. My family and I are very excited about the challenge and opportunity. Having previously spent time in West Texas and Eastern New Mexico, we are delighted to be joining a great team of educators and become members of what is clearly a wonderful community."

Myers is married to Patricia and they have two daughters, Audrey, 19, and Samantha, 17. Myers plans to join the district as soon as he and the Mount Pleasant Board of Trustees mutually agree upon a resignation date.
