WILDCAT MARCHING BAND WINS “ZIA NEW MEXICO CHAMPION” & “ZIA GRAND CHAMPION”

Congratulations to the Wildcat Marching Band! The Marching Band competed last Saturday at the “Zia Marching Fiesta,” which was held in Albuquerque. The Wildcat Marching Band competed against 32 bands from New Mexico, Texas, and Colorado.

In the preliminary competition, the Wildcat Marching Band finished “1st in Class,” “1st Overall,” and won two of three “Caption Awards.” The Caption Awards won were for “Best Musical Achievement” and “Best Visual Effect.”

In Finals competition, the Wildcat Marching Band won all three “Caption Awards,” which were “Best Musical Achievement,” “Best Visual Effect,” and “Best General Effect.” The Band also captured the “Zia New Mexico Champion” and the “Zia Grand Champion” awards!
