### CLOVIS HIGH SCHOOL & CHS FRESHMAN ACADEMY CHOIR STUDENTS RECEIVE "SUPERIOR & OUTSTANDING" RATINGS

Congratulations to the Clovis High School and Freshman Academy Choral students and their directors, Marsha Brandon and Janice Pacheco as well as the solo teachers and accompanists Peggy Brady, Wayne Anderson, Virginia Morrison, and Brian Uerling for an outstanding showing at the Southeast District Solo and Ensemble Festival held at Eastern New Mexico University (ENMU) on October 6, 2011. The Festival judges were from ENMU and Texas Tech University, Lubbock, Texas.

In the Solo competition, fifty-nine (59) students from Clovis were awarded the top rating of "Superior" and thirty-one (31) students the rating of "Excellent." Additionally, Shane Dalton, CHS Junior, received the "Outstanding Soloist" award.

In the Ensemble competition, nine (9) ensembles from Clovis received the top rating of "Superior" and one (1) was awarded the rating of "Excellent."
