James Bickley and Lockwood Elementary Schools have been selected to receive an Incentive Award from the No Child Left Behind Title III and State Bilingual Education Programs.

The No Child Left Behind Act – Title III provides recognition for state education agencies where English Language Learners are succeeding. To be eligible for an incentive award, schools must provide evidence of effectiveness according to the following student performance criteria:

1. Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAOs), including:
 - a. "Making Progress" in English Language Proficiency
 - b. "Attaining Proficiency" in the English Language
 - c. Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)
2. Short-Cycle Assessment Data
3. Qualitative Measures – other data, such as success stories of accomplishments by the English Language Learner student group.

James Bickley and Lockwood Elementary Schools continue to hold strong to effective practices and are making a difference in the success of all students.

Both schools will be recognized at the "Bilingual Day at the Legislature" celebration at the State Capitol Rotunda in Santa Fe on February 18th from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm.
