CHOIRS & BANDS COMPETE IN SOUTHEAST NEW MEXICO MUSIC EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION LARGE GROUP CONCERT & SIGHT-READING FESTIVAL

Choirs and Bands from Marshall and Yucca Middle Schools, Clovis High School Freshman Academy, and Clovis High School competed last week in the Southeast New Mexico Music Educators Association Large Group Concert and Sight-Reading Festival. Eastern New Mexico University sponsored the Choir Festival and the Band Festival was held at Hobbs High School.

A panel consisting of three judges rated each Band and Choir concert performance, as well as a sight-reading performance, on the following scale: Superior, Excellent, Good, Fair, or Poor.

Of the 19 groups that competed from Clovis Schools, 17 received a "Sweepstakes Plaque!" Groups receiving the "Sweepstakes Plaque" were:

Marshall Middle School: Men's Choir, Mixed Choir, Varsity Band

Yucca Middle School: 7th Grade Women's Choir, Men's Choir, Mixed Choir, Varsity Band

CHS Freshman Academy: Women's Choir, Men's Choir, Mixed Choir, Band

Clovis High School: Women's Choir II, Men's Choir, Women's Choir I, Mixed Choir, Concert Band, Symphony Band

Two groups received a "Superior" rating in concert and an "Excellent" rating in sight-reading. Those groups were: Marshall MS Women's Choir and the Yucca MS 8th Grade Women's Choir.
